How to make a Tea Towel Tote Bag

Everyone is trying to reduce the need for plastic bags, so why not whip up some cute tea towel tote bags to shop in style.

Step 1

Choose a pretty tea towel – you can usually find brand new tea towels at the Op Shop for less than \$2.

You will also need:

Twill Tape (can be found at Spotlight)
Erasable Fabric Marker or Fabric Pencil
Pins Scissors
Ruler Sewing Machine



Step 2

Fold the tea towel in half lengthways, with the right sides facing out



Step 3

Using a ruler, rule a line 10 centimetres in from each edge using a fabric marker. Turn the tea towel over and repeat this on the other side too



Step 4

Measure the length of the line – now it's time for some simple maths.

To cut the twill tape straps – Take the length of the ruled line and double it, and then add 50 centimetres (for the curve of the handle).

Cut two separate straps at this length



Step 5

Line up the straps against the ruled line and securely pin into place on both sides.



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Step 6

Using your sewing machine, sew the straps onto the tea towel. Make sure to sew along both sides of the twill tape



Step 7

Fold your tea towel in half lengthwise again, but this time with the right sides facing together. Make sure that your handles line up nicely together and pin both side seams together



Step 8

Sew a straight line of stitching down both sides of the tea towel to create a bag



Step 9

To hide the cut edges of the twill tape, sew a straight line of stitching along the bottom of your bag approximately 1 centimetre in from the bottom



Step 10

Turn your bag back out to the right way and head to the shops!
